## READINGS August 31, 2025: 12th Sunday after Pentecost

INTRODUCTION: Invited and inviting — that is the nature of the church. By God's grace in holy baptism we have a place at Christ's banquet table. When, by the power of that same Spirit, humility and mutual love continue among us, the church can be more inviting still. FIRST READING: Proverbs 25:6-7a: The book of Proverbs is part of a collection of writings known as wisdom literature. Wisdom literature gave directions to Israel's leaders and people for the conduct of daily life. Today's reading is about humility.

PSALM: Psalm 112

SECOND READING: Hebrews 13:1-8, 15-16: The conclusion of the letter to the Hebrews contains suggestions for the conduct of a holy life, all of which are shaped by God's love toward us in Jesus Christ.

GOSPEL: Luke 14:1, 7-14: Jesus observes guests jockeying for position at the table. He uses the opportunity to teach his hearers to choose humility rather than self-exaltation. Jesus also makes an appeal for hosts to imitate God's gracious hospitality to those in need.
