READINGS: June 14, 2026: 3rd Sunday after Pentecost

INTRODUCTION: Moses tells the Israelites that they are called to be a priestly kingdom and a holy people. Jesus sends out the disciples as laborers into the harvest. In baptism we too are anointed for ministry, sharing God's compassion with our needy world. From the Lord's table we go forth to proclaim the good news, to heal the sick, and to share our bread with the hungry.

FIRST READING: Exodus 19:2-8a: At Sinai God assured Israel, "You shall be my treasured possession," and commissioned them to serve as mediating priests for the nations. The people commit themselves completely to God's will.

PSALM: Psalm 100

SECOND READING: Romans 5:1-8: *We are no longer God's enemies but have peace with God because we were brought into a right relationship with God through Christ's death.*

GOSPEL: Matthew 9:35 – 10:8 [9-23]: *The mission of Jesus' followers is to continue the mission of Jesus himself. Here, he instructs his first disciples as to how they might proclaim the gospel through their words and deeds.*

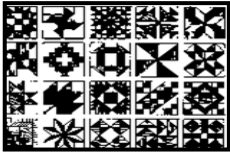
